Who is Eligible for Our Services?

All Avery County residents are eligible to receive services through Volunteer Avery County, but priority is given to those with an unforeseen crisis (such as a house fire or injury), those on limited incomes, the elderly and families with children living in he home.

Applicants must provide financial information and work with the Volunteer Avery County Coordinator to determine whether there are other sources of help for their particular need.

How Do We Help?

We match people whishing to volunteer with an opportunity to help an individual or a family or an organization in need of assistance.

We provide funds and resources to meet emergency needs that cannot be provided by any other agency or organization. We are there for those needs that fall between the cracks but are still basic needs.

Examples of services include providing fire wood or emergency fuel, clothing, food, repairs to homes or vehicles, and some educational and healthcare needs.
